

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: Does this waiver apply to **CEU classes**?

Answer: No, it does not apply to CEU classes, because CEU classes do not have tuition, only fees.

Question: Do the student have to be **admitted to a program**, or can he/she apply for a waiver, if he/she just wants to take an individual class?

Answer: The form includes six (6) scenarios, under which someone may receive a tuition waiver. When applying for a tuition waiver for the first time, admission to a program is not a requirement. However, for some of the waivers, admission to a program is required, if the student wants to continue to receive the waiver.

Question: When is the **due date** for the completed form to be turned in?

Answer: The due date varies according to semester; however, short-term classes that start after the due dates below, will receive an extension:

- **Summer 2018 – July 1, 2018**
- **Fall 2018 – October 1, 2018**
- **Spring 2019 – March 1, 2019**

Question: Does a student have to have all “A” **grades** in order to be eligible for a waiver?

Answer: No. However, when taking classes under the waiver, the student must make satisfactory academic progress, which means (1) pass 2/3 of his/her classes and (2) have an overall grade point average of 2.0 (Grade “C”) in order to be eligible for the waiver the next semester.

Question: What if a **student owes money** to the College, is he/she still eligible for a tuition waiver?

Answer: As long as the balance is \$500 or less, yes, the student is eligible for the tuition waiver. If the student owes a higher balance, he/she must work out a payment plan with the Business Office and reduce the balance to \$500 or less.

Question: Is it still necessary to **apply for financial aid**?

Answer: For students taking multiple courses, it is strongly recommended to participate in financial aid counseling and to apply for financial aid, because the cost of attending college is not limited to tuition, but also includes various fees and textbooks/class materials.

Question: Does this waiver include **books and fees**?

Answer: While tuition will be waived, students are responsible for registration fees, lab kits, lab supplies, art supplies, textbooks and any special costs identified for the course(s) in the College Catalog.

Question: Does this waiver apply to **dual credit courses**?

Answer: No it does not.

Question: Can the tuition waiver be applied to **repeat classes**, either because the student did poorly or because the student wants to take the class again for personal interest?

Answer: No, the tuition waiver can be applied once to a class, but not repeatedly.
