Today, The North Slope Borough Mayor Harry Brower issued a Hunker Down Order 10-2020 in Utqiagvik due to the increase cases of COVID-19 within our community. As the spread of the coronavirus continues, our top priority continues to be the health and safety of our college community. As a result of this order, we will be closing campus down and transitioning back to telework status starting today, September 1, 2020 to September 15, 2020.

Ilisagvik advises the following:


- All online/distance delivered courses will continue as is. All in-person courses currently offered will continue via online/distance delivery.
