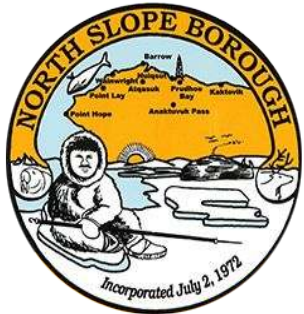

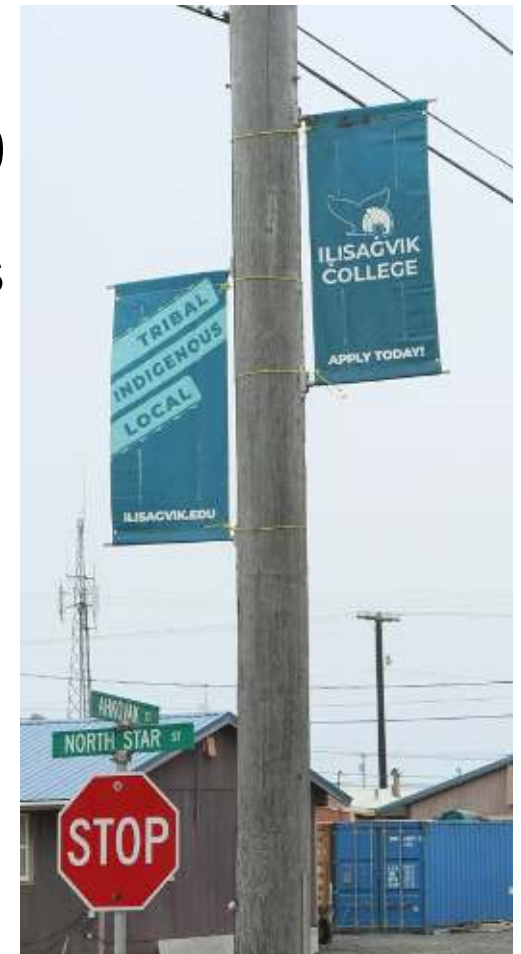
Looking ahead

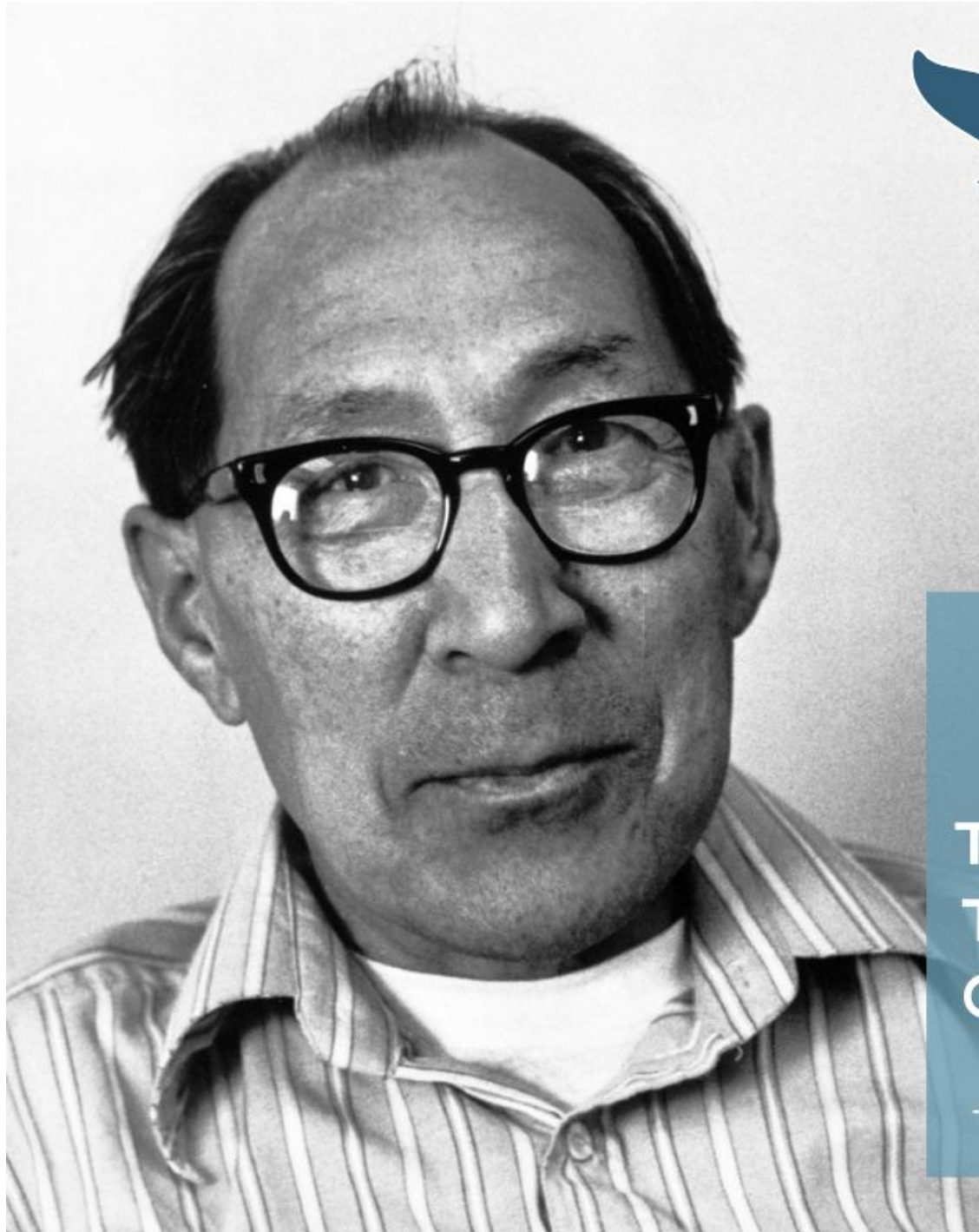
