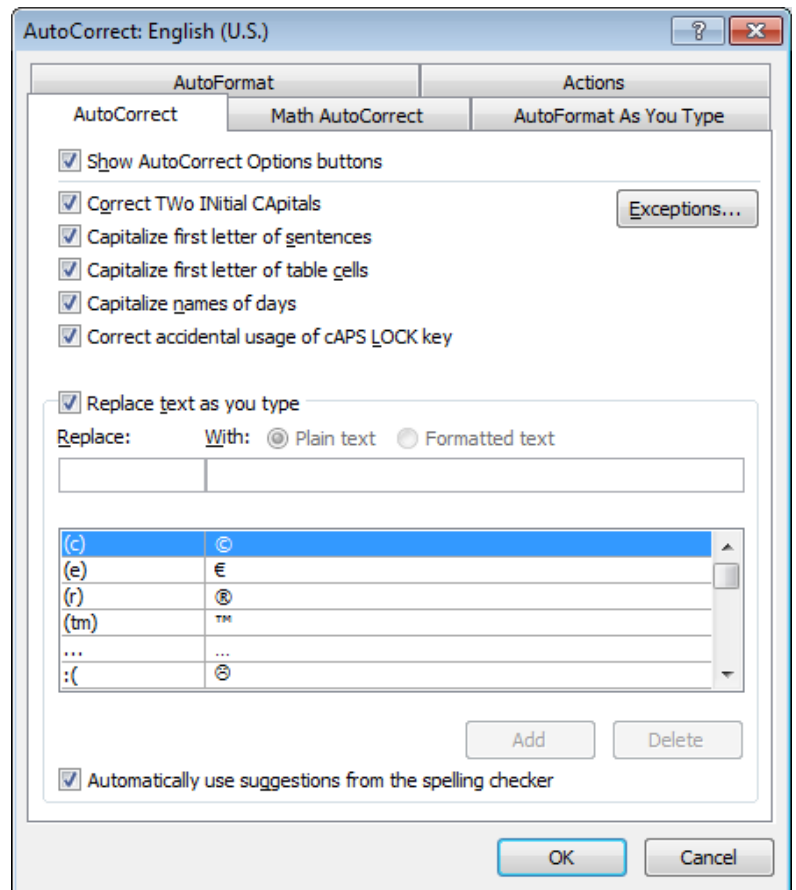


How to Add Iñupiaq Diacritic Marks onto Your Dell Computer

1. The Iñupiaq Diacritic Marks are the special symbols in the Iñupiaq language that are not in the English language.
2. These instructions are for a dell computer.
3. Once this form is e-mailed to you, you will copy and paste each of the diacritic marks one by one and follow the instructions below. ñ ṅ ġ ! † ‡

Here's How

1. In **Word**, select *File: Options*
2. In the **Options** Window select *Proofing*
3. Click "Auto Correct Options"
4. For each line above copy one diacritic mark to be replaced to "Replace." You will replace the following for the following:
 - (n) = ñ
 - (nn) = ṅ
 - (g) = ġ
 - (ll) = !
 - (lll) = †
 - (llll) = ‡
5. Copy "correct" item to "With"
6. Click "OK"
