NEW COURSES

ANS 293 Leadership in a Diverse World

This course will examine the concept of leadership in both the Indigenous and Western perspective. Students will explore what occurs when Indigenous and Western styles are integrated as well as what leadership looks like holistically, from the past to the present and into the future.

ANTH 294 Fundamentals of Archaeology:

Archaeology is the study of past human behavior through physical traces it left behind. This course introduces you to the methods archaeologists use to make sense of the past. It covers how sites are found and excavated, and how the finds are studied. It also covers ethics of archaeology.

ANTH 294 Archeology Laboratory Methods

This course introduces students to the basic methods and techniques used to analyze archaeological materials. Students will acquire familiarity with North Slope artifact types, raw materials and manufacturing techniques. They will learn skills needed to participate in archaeological projects and work as entry-level archaeological lab technicians. There is a separate hands-on laboratory module which can be taken concurrently.

ANTH 294 Archeology Laboratory Methods, Lab

This is the laboratory component of the Archaeological Lab Methods course, and can be taken concurrently. The lab gives students a hands-on introduction to the basic methods and techniques used to analyze archaeological materials. Students will get hands-on experience with North Slope artifact types and raw materials. They will learn and practice skills needed to participate in archaeological projects and work as entry-level archaeological lab technicians.

ED 101 Introduction to Early Childhood Profession

This course includes a historical foundation on current issues and trends surrounding early childhood and provides exposure to a variety of developmentally appropriate programs designed to meet the diverse needs of children and families. Topics include the importance of being an advocate, supporting Indigenous children's development, creating an inclusive environment, professionalism and ethical conduct, identification of resources such as the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), and the exploration of career opportunities.

ED 104 Child Development

This course provides a foundation designed to increase knowledge and understanding of child development from prenatal to age three. Anticipating the emerging development during the rapid growth of these critical years will be emphasized. Students will examine domains, theories, cultural perspectives and multiple influences on development, with an emphasis on prenatal development, healthy child-birth, the importance of relationships, and meaningful environments. Opportunities for observation, reflection, and early intervention in a preschool setting will be provided.

PHYS 194 Physics I

This algebra-based physics course is designed for students who are pursuing a career in health related fields, life science, or other disciplines including architecture and environmental science. This first course deals with Newtonian and fluids mechanics, thermodynamics, wave motion and sound. *Prerequisite: Math 105 or higher (Knowledge of Geometry and Trigonometry will be helpful).*

KEY TO COURSE AVAILABILITY

Teleconference: Students residing in Barrow attend class sessions in person. Students not in Barrow, can participate at the given time from any location by dialing the teleconference number provided.

Teleconf/c-Live: Students residing in Barrow, attend class sessions in person. Students not in Barrow can participate at the given time from any location by dialing the teleconference number provided. Additionally, they need a computer with Internet access in close proximity, in order to view the visual components, such as class notes and other instructional materials.

Online/c-Live: Students participate (1) in scheduled class sessions using a computer with internet access and (2) online, at their own convenience.

Online: Students participate at their own convenience, using a computer with internet access.

A BLENDED course will have scheduled class sessions as well as required online interaction.
